Professional Biography

Bishop Dr. Christopher A. Lewis is a seasoned pastor, church leader, author, evangelist, and community developer with more than three decades of experience in ministry, leadership development, church revitalization, and global outreach. Born in the Republic of Guyana, South America, he began his life of faith and ministry as a teenager and has since dedicated his calling to preaching, teaching, mentoring, and mobilizing leaders for transformational service.

Dr. Lewis has served in pastoral and administrative leadership across Guyana, the United States, and the broader global church. His ministry has taken him throughout the Caribbean, North America, the United Kingdom, Africa, and beyond, where he has ministered as a revival speaker, worship leader, musician, church planter, and conference speaker. He has also appeared as a featured guest on the Trinity Broadcasting Network and on radio stations throughout South Florida.

As a pastor and leader, Dr. Lewis is known for his collaborative, multicultural, and mission-focused approach to ministry. He has trained and developed hundreds of ministers, pastors, lay leaders, and church teams across multiple regions, equipping them for effective service in local churches and communities. His leadership experience includes senior pastoral ministry, church planting, ministry restructuring, leadership coaching, community engagement, fundraising, missions, and church revitalization initiatives.

Dr. Lewis previously served as Senior Pastor of Christian Community Church of God in Lauderhill, Florida; Victory Worship Center Church of God in Chicago, Illinois; and Harvestime New Testament Church of God in Guyana, South America. In these roles, he provided spiritual leadership, developed ministry teams, organized worship and outreach initiatives, led community development efforts, facilitated pastoral care, and oversaw major church growth and revitalization projects. His work has included preaching, teaching, counseling, leadership training, evangelistic crusades, mission outreach, civic engagement, and pastoral oversight.

A highly educated theological leader, Dr. Lewis holds a Bachelor of Arts in Ministry with an emphasis in Multicultural Ministry from National Bible College and Seminary in Fort Washington, Maryland; a Master of Arts in Theological Studies with an emphasis in Urban Ministry from Trinity International University; and a Doctor of Ministry in Missional Pastoral Leadership from South Florida Theological Seminary.

In recognition of his commitment to community transformation, Dr. Lewis has worked closely with civic leaders and municipalities to advance holistic welfare, affordable housing, service initiatives, and faith-based community development. He was appointed by the City of Lauderhill to serve on the Affordable Housing Committee, reflecting his long-standing commitment to practical service and compassionate leadership beyond the walls of the church.

On July 31, at the Church of God 80th International General Assembly in Orlando, Florida, Dr. Lewis was appointed State Administrative Bishop of the Garden State of New Jersey. In this role, he provides servant leadership and administrative oversight to more than sixty multicultural churches and two hundred ministers, working alongside his wife, Annette, to strengthen churches, support pastors, and advance the mission of the Church of God throughout New Jersey.

Eloquent, dynamic, and deeply committed to the call of God, Dr. Lewis is recognized as a gifted communicator, anointed psalmist, mentor, and family man. His ministry philosophy emphasizes that spiritual transformation should produce social transformation, and that the good news of Jesus Christ becomes most compelling when demonstrated through good deeds, service, and compassion.

Dr. Lewis is married to Annette, and together they are the proud parents of two children, Christiana and Alexander. He continues to lead with conviction, humility, and a deep commitment to empowering people, strengthening churches, and inspiring his generation to become agents of change.
